During this family friendly weekend, sign the kids up for a pumpkin carving contest on Saturday and Sunday. See the pumpkin display between 4th and 5th streets on Bennett Avenue. Fun and spooky prizes await! When the kids aren't busy carving pumpkins, check out the Kid's Zone at the Pocket Park and the Colorado National Guard display on Bennett Avenue and 5th Street.

Shop at various vendors and satisfy cravings at food trucks on Bennett Avenue. Adults enjoy a remarkable fall-themed beer garden near the live music stage at 2nd and Bennett.
